1)	People Ensure sufficient staff available to handle system demands					
2)	Consider skills, experience, knowledge and qualification distribution across shifts • Possible prolonged staff loss due to sickness					
3)	Consider reduced staffing levels and increasing workloads when considering the rigour of audit response times etc (i.e., do not unnecessarily increase pressure on organizations)					
4)	Process Ensure sensitivity to the challenges faced by people as they recover normal operation					
5)	Ensure sensitivity of inspectors and auditors					
6)	Consider proportionate oversight during phased return to normal operation					
7)	Consider receiving requests for waivers					
8)	Consider reminding all stakeholders to involve their safety managers in the recovery					
9)	Consider flight time limit alleviations
