STATES RESPONSE TO ICAO STATE LETTER Ref.: EC 6/3 – 20/46

DATED: 18 March 2020

Subject: Adherence to relevant ICAO Annex 9 – *Facilitation* Standards; and Actions taken by Member States to reduce the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) by air transport and to protect the health of air travellers and the aviation personnel.

Required action by States: Member States are urged to: a) establish National Facilitation Committees in line with Annex 9 Standard 8.19; b) adhere to Annex 9 Standards 4.7 and 8.8 related to air cargo operations; c) take into account the guidance material in relation to screening measures; and d) provide ICAO with their actions taken to reduce the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) by air transport aiming at protecting the health of air travellers and aviation personnel, no later than 30 April 2020.
