1. INTRODUCTION

The safety and reliability of aircraft operations are fundamentally dependent on effective airworthiness management and a comprehensive air carrier certification framework. With the aviation industry continuously evolving, through technological advancements, increasing air traffic, and complex regulatory requirements, it is essential that **Airworthiness and Operations Inspectors** responsible for safety oversight remain updated on the latest standards and recommended practices.

EAC-CASSOA in collaboration with the Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority (TCAA) has organized a workshop titled “**Aircraft Airworthiness and Air Carrier Certification**” to be held in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania.

2. WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this training workshop are to:

- a Provide in-depth knowledge on operator certification processes.
- b Clarify the roles and responsibilities of operators and regulatory authorities.
- c Enhance participants' understanding of continuing airworthiness, quality systems, and Operator's SMS
- d Familiarize participants with essential regulatory documents;
- e Strengthen the capacity of national aviation oversight bodies to implement and monitor effective compliance systems

5. TRANSPORTATION

- a) Passengers arriving at Julius Nyerere International Airport are advised to use only authorized taxis available at the designated airport taxi stand. Taxi services operate under a zone-based pricing system, with standardized fares depending on the destination within Dar es Salaam and surrounding areas. Passengers are encouraged to confirm the applicable fare with the driver before departure and avoid unregistered taxi operators for safety and reliability.
- b) Participants residing outside Four Points Hotel are required to make their own transport arrangement to the Workshop venue.

6. FOREIGN EXCHANGE

Foreign exchange (Forex) services are available outside the arrivals area at Julius Nyerere International Airport (JNIA), and at various Banks and Bureau de Change across the city.

Banking hours are from 08:00 to 16:30 on weekdays and from 08:00 to 12:00 on Saturdays.

7. SAFETY AND SECURITY

Dar es Salaam, United Republic of Tanzania, is generally a safe and welcoming city for visitors. Security is overseen by national and local authorities, with established systems in place to support public safety and emergency response. The country is known for its hospitality and continues to provide a stable and secure environment for international events and participants.

Therefore, visitors and participants can expect a comfortable and well-organized setting throughout their stay in Dar es Salaam.

Nevertheless, it is recommended to remain mindful of the following important information:

- a) Always carry a valid form of identification (passport or a copy);
- b) Follow guidance provided by event organizers and local authorities;
- c) Use reputable transport services, such as hotel-arranged taxis or registered ride services;
- d) Avoid walking alone at night in unfamiliar or poorly lit areas;
- e) Keep valuables secure and avoid displaying expensive items in public;
- f) Be cautious in crowded places such as markets and transport hubs;
- g) Use ATMs located in secure areas (e.g., banks or hotels);
- h) Keep emergency contact numbers readily accessible; and
- i) Respect local laws, customs, and cultural norms.

8. WEATHER AND DRESS CODE

It is strongly recommended that participants have travel insurance (including health) for the Dar es Salaam, United Republic of Tanzania, has a tropical climate characterized by warm temperatures and relatively high humidity throughout the year. Daytime temperatures typically range between 25°C and 32°C. Depending on the season, occasional rainfall may occur, particularly during the long rains (March to May) and short rains (October to December).

Participants are encouraged to dress comfortably and appropriately for the warm climate while maintaining a professional appearance during workshop sessions. Light, breathable fabrics such as cotton or linen are recommended.

9. HEALTH AND MEDICAL INFORMATION

Yellow fever vaccination is mandatory for travellers arriving from yellow fever endemic countries. More information can be obtained from the Ministry of Health website.
